Kericho to build new medical drug stores in all sub counties-official

In an effort to ensure ready availability of drugs for its health facilities, the County Government of Kericho has started building central medical drug stores in various sub counties.

According to the County's Health Services Department Chief Officer Dr. David Ekuwam, the county has so far set up three medical stores, one at

the main referral hospital, and two others at Singowet and Londiani.

"As a County, we have given critical attention to the health care system and putting up stores for bigger consignments of drugs is part of our effort to deliver drugs to facilities across the county", he said.

He said that in the next financial year, they will be adding a fourth one after realizing that the three are still inad-

equated if they have to end delays in delivery of drugs to the health facilities.

Dr. Ekuwam explained that sometimes, orders for medication delivered directly at the grassroots expire while other facilities also experience stock-outs. According to him, investing in the county supply infrastructure will narrow the critical balance between overstocking and stock-outs.

"Having a central medical

store will address the two challenges of stock-outs and also expiry even as we continue to replenish and distribute what

is required," he said



The roll out of the Universal Health Care (UHC), the Chief Officer said, has seen the

county increase its community units from 45 to 137 with a target of 200 in the near future to take better care of all the 901,000 citizens of the county.

The role of a community health unit is to bring services closer to the people that need them.

"In the next year or so we will fill the gap of 43 units so that we have the 200 community units at the community level", he said

Kericho County is one of the few in the country that have consistently allocated the recommended 30 percent of their budget towards health care.
