The representatives said Kazi Mtaani had kept thousands of the youth away from crime.

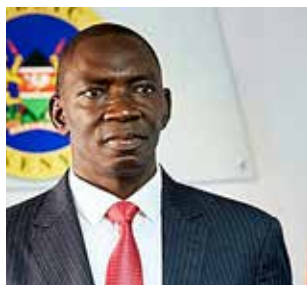

The office of the Government Spokesperson has embarked on a public sensitization campaign to increase the number of youths

employed online through the Ajira Digital Programme.

Launched in 2016, Ajira Digital is a government programme under the Ministry of Information, Communications and Technology (ICT) to enhance youth empowerment. The programme offers youths free basic training and mentorship on how to make money online from home.

Among the trainings on offer are digital marketing skills, transcription, content writing and data entry skills as well as provision of online

business support services.

The programme also encourages local companies and the public sector to create digital work and make Kenya a freelance hub and the global destination for online work.

At least 1.2 million youths in Kenya are earning money through online jobs, with some making more per month than they would do informal employment.

The Government Spokesperson noted that Ajira programme could offer even more employment opportunities if

more youth enrolled themselves.

"Ajira Digital makes it possible for the youth to transcend borders, because there are more job opportunities out there," said Col. Oguna.

To facilitate the programme, the government is working to establish digital hubs across the country where the youth can access free Wi-Fi services to log in, get trained and apply for online jobs.
