CONSTRUCTION OF THREE WATER HARVESTING STRUCTURES IN THARAKA-NITHI COUNTY

The Government of Kenya has received financial assistance from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) towards financing the Upper Tana Catchment Natural Resources Management Project. The project completion date is 31st December 2022 and the closure date is 30th June 2023. The goal of the project is to contribute to rural poverty reduction in the Upper Tana Catchment and the project objectives are;

- (a) Increased sustainable food production and incomes; and
- (b) Sustainable management of natural resources for provision of environmental services.

The Project Lead Agency is the Ministry of Water, Sanitation and Irrigation. The Project is being implemented in six (6) Counties namely Murang'a, Nyeri, Kirinyaga, Embu, Tharaka-Nithi, and Meru.

Towards accomplishing its objectives, the Upper Tana Catchment Natural Resources Management Project (UTaNRMP) intends to use part of the funds to procure the works in water harvesting.
